This year's Speech Day was held face-to-face on 26 November 2021, a sign of return to normalcy, and it was also broadcast live online. Students with excellent achievements in various subjects and extra-curricular activities were commended on the day.

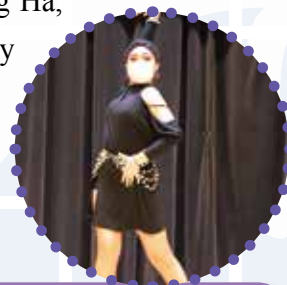


The ceremony kicked off with the school Principal, Mr. Lee's report on the students' outstanding achievements in various internal and external examinations in the 2020/2021 academic year. In particular, SEK students' outstanding achievement in English Language in the 2021 HKDSE Examination with 84.5% passing rate, which is reported to be 4.5% higher than the HK average, was greatly inspiring to the students and teachers alike. Our students also attained encouraging results in the IGCSE/GCE Chinese language examination with almost 74.6% candidates obtaining Level 3 or above.



Our school invited Mr. Neville S. Shroff, JP, Chairman and CEO of Shroff and Company Ltd., as the Guest of Honour of the event. Mr. Shroff delivered a very thought-provoking speech on how to embrace learning as an everyday life culture not just in terms of academics and grades but also in sports, music and arts. According to Mr. Shroff, students as learners should always keep themselves abreast of the rapidly transforming digital and non-digital human life and culture.

Other distinguished guests invited to the ceremony included Ms. Kwok Pui Tai, Patty, the Chief School Development Officer of Yau Tsim Mong District, Mrs. Farida N. Shroff, the donor of Education Support Fund, Mr. Robbie McRobbie, Chief Executive Officer of Hong Kong Rugby Union, Ms. Yeung Kwong Mong Ha, former Principal, Ms. Rachel C. Galang, the PTA Chairlady, Mr. G. S. Batra, the PTA Honorary Auditor, and Dr. Ricky Van Yip Tso, a SEK Alumnus and Assistant Professor of the Education University of Hong Kong. The ceremony was concluded with multicultural performances by students including a Latin dance by 3B Jenny Yu, an Indian Punjabi dance by the Banghra Warriors and Chinese music medley by our Chinese music ensemble.





First Staff Development Day

The First Staff Development Day was held on 16 October 2021 and the theme was 'Revitalize ourselves'. It started with a meditation training by Raja Yoga Centre. The second session was the Laughter Yoga and Workshop by Inspire2aspire. Both

sessions create a relaxed environment for teachers to reduce stress, promote a greater sense of well-being, and connect with others.

In the afternoon, two tours were arranged by the Staff Support and Development

Team in order to understand the history of Hong Kong through visiting some revitalization projects. One of the tours is a self-guided tour of visiting Tai Kwun. From Heritage Walks to Architecture Walking Guide, teachers downloaded the Tai Kwun App, picked a thematic route of their choice and learnt about the concepts and stories behind the revitalised site. Similar to the nearby Tai Kwun, Central Market was a former government property which was an important testament to the confluence of Chinese and Western cultures in Hong Kong. After the Urban Renewal Authority (URA) had tasked to implement the revitalisation works, Central Market is now a leisure landmark and open space. Visiting Central Market also brings a rich experience for teachers to learn the revitalisation implement work.

It was surely a fruitful day for every staff member and our students would, eventually, benefit from it.

MVPA 60+ Promotion Day 2021

According to World Health Organization and EDB guidelines, children and adolescents aged 5-17 years should do at least an average of 60 minutes per day of moderate-to-vigorous intensity, mostly aerobic, physical activity (MVPA 60+), across the week. They should also incorporate vigorous-intensity aerobic activities, as well as those that strengthen muscles and bones, at least 3 days a week. To promote MVPA 60+ and encourage students to exercise, our school organized an MVPA 60+ Promotion Day on 5 & 6 October 2021.



On the first day of the event, students from different houses, Blue House, Red House, Green House and Yellow House, competed against each other for top positions on Indoor Bike, Horizontal Jump, Kangaroo Jump and Shot Put in the school hall and in the covered playground.



On the second day, students from different houses competed on Basketball, Volleyball, and Dodgeball matches in the school playground. Competition teams were divided into Junior and Senior form teams, and boys and girls teams. In all the groups, teams from Blue House scored highest in almost all the events securing the champion's spot with 575 total scores, while Green House became the First Runner-up with 431 points. The Yellow and Red Houses secured the third and fourth positions respectively.

The MVPA60+ events were live broadcast across the campus for students and teachers to view.

On 19 November 2021 – Parents' Night cum 30th Parents-Teachers' Association (PTA) AGM was held in the school hall.

An entertainment programme was organized and our talented students kept the audience entertained until the formal proceedings for the evening commenced. During the ceremony, our Principal, Mr. Lee Tung Ching, welcomed the parents in the school hall for this important event and thanked them for their support. Then the PTA Chairperson, Mrs. Rachel C. Galang delivered a speech to parents and students emphasizing the importance of sense of belonging to school. This was followed by the report of the teacher in charge of the PTA, Mr. Kumar, who highlighted the achievements made during the past year, and Ms. Dunn Ling, reporting on the statements of accounts. Certificates were then presented to the outgoing members of the PTA Executive Committee. New teacher members appointed to serve the PTA Executive committee meeting were introduced after that. After voting for the SMC representative, the ceremony came to an end, and parents met their children's class teachers individually to understand their children's academic performance and social life at school. 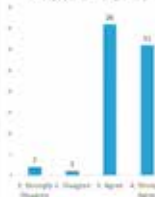

S1 Orientation Day Camp Survey Result

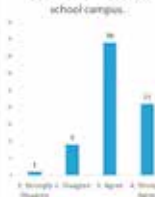
67 students (95.7%) agree that "I enjoyed the day camp."

1. I enjoyed the day camp.



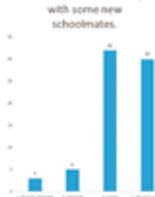
60 students (85.7%) agree that "I know more about the school campus."

2. I know more about the school campus.



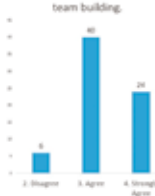

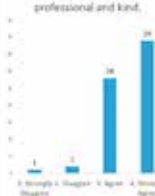

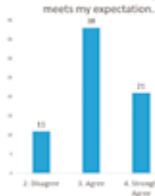

近年，香港社會愈來愈關心非華語學生中文教育課題，非華語學生在香港的教育體系中，人數愈來愈多，不論新來港的，或者在香港土生土長的亦然；一般文法中學，經常收到不少非華語學生的入學申請；而且，由於學生的文化和成長背景不同，學生的學習差異嚴重，非華語學生中文教育課題，值得關注。

是次官立中學聯校教師工作坊，作為一個平台，讓各官立中學友校互相交流，探討支援非華語學生學習中文的有效方法，分享校本經驗，並作專業交流。

官立嘉道理爵士中學（西九龍）吳詠儀老師分享「課本課程設計」，尤其如何設計和推展「非華語生文憑試中文科調適課程」。任巧恩老師分享「中文教育學習領域活動」，例如參加教育局語文教學支援組計劃、參加中文大學 EduVenture 虛擬實景教學計劃、主辦聯校教師及學生交流、從繪本教學出發進行跨學科學習計劃和推廣中國文化活動等，如何透過各項活動，讓非華語學生從多元方式學習中文。

是次工作坊最具價值之處，是分組交流環節——各組來自不同官立中學的教師們，分享校本經驗，彼此取經，著實達至交流之果效，教我們互相砥礪，彼此有所進益。

從活動問卷所見，參加教師對校本課程剪裁甚感興趣，希望了解如何提升學生學習中文的動機，並期待知悉更多如何調適校內評估工具的方法，以及了解公開考試的要求。教師們對是次交流活動感到非常滿意，成果令人鼓舞。

期待官立中學非華語學生中文科「教師學習圈」工作坊，日後繼續舉辦，探討更多支援非華語學生學習中文的有效方法。

HKUST Underwater Robot Competition

On 9 July 2021, 5 students, 4A Velappan Shannia Ferrer, 4B Wu Supeng, 5B Murtaza Ali, 5C Baig Mirza Mustafa, and 6A Hussain Qasim, of our school participated in the 2021 Underwater Robot Competition, which was launched by the Hong Kong University of Science and Technology.

A total of 70 teams, comprising students from diverse social and educational backgrounds, and from different types of schools, participated in the competition. First, student mentors from HKUST provided the participants with training on basic robot skills, and then, throughout the competition, guided them to design unique underwater robots capable of completing a series of underwater missions.

Our school team performed well and was awarded a prize, and also Achievement Level Bronze. Congratulations to the winners, and we hope they will continue to develop their potential in the areas of science and technology.

On 18 to 20 December 2021, Mr. Chan Ka Wai and Dr. Singh Manpreet guided 4 students, 2D Chen Megan, 2D Igloria Chloe Faye, 5A Su Jialin and 5B Wong Hau Hei, to join a three-day STEM Winter Camp organized by the Hong Kong Institute of Construction.

The first two days of the camp were at Construction Industry College at Sheung Shui, where the students had the chance to learn the basics of engineering skills and construct a working model of the tower crane from scratch materials. They used the concepts learnt in Physics lessons to design the working model of the tower crane and constructed it using wooden pieces. They had to do the calculations carefully to adjust the length and the load of the tower. In the camp, they also learnt about different engineering techniques and used different engineering tools to finalize the model.

The last day of the camp was organized at CIC Zero Carbon Park in Kowloon Bay, where the students had to display their working models to a team of judges. The most important part of our

students' model was the design of their model. Inspired by the environmental setting in the Zero Carbon Park, our students chose the Green as the theme of the tower crane, and displayed excellent presentation skills in front of the selection panel. Because of their outstanding performance, they grabbed the Champion's title among the 21 participating teams from various other schools.

This STEM camp has boosted students' confidence in dealing with real-life science problems and exposed them to the prospects of engineering career.
